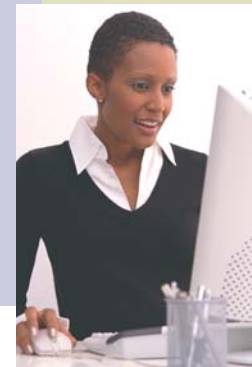

### *Librarians Win:*



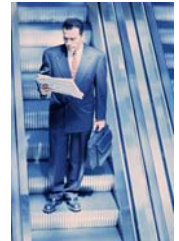
Law librarians believe that writing articles for legal publications helps them build a higher profile among the legal community, both as individual authors and as a profession.
