## General Information on When the Stay of Eviction forms should be Completed.

## I. Petition for Stay of Eviction Form

**If you have received a Summons and Complaint** for an eviction case, and have applied for Emergency Assistance (EA), then you can file the form titled *Petition for Stay of Eviction Based on Application for Emergency Assistance*. Once you complete the form, you need to file it at the courthouse in the county in where your eviction case is pending.

## II. Statement and Order on Eligibility Form

There are two instances where you **must** complete the form titled *Statement and Order on Eligibility to Receive or Receipt of Emergency Assistance*.

1. If you filed the *Petition for Stay of Eviction* with the court, AND you have been denied EA benefits, then you must complete the *Statement and Order on Eligibility* form and file it at the courthouse in the county in where you were being evicted.

## OR

2. If you filed the *Petition for Stay of Eviction* with the court, AND 1) you have been approved for EA benefits and 2) your current or new landlord has received the assistance, then you must complete the *Statement and Order on Eligibility* form and file it at the courthouse in the county in where you were being evicted.
